## BSE AND VETERINARY MEDICINES

Thank you for your minute of 10 June. I should have thought that it would not be in accord with the intention of the SI to seek to use the Sera and Glandular Products Order to cater for a BSE risk and that it would be difficult to sustain a case if challenged.

I do not have a copy of EC 81/851 and am unable to comment on its usefulness but you may wish to consider seeking advice from Legal Branch as to how to achieve the desired objective. In my view the CJD experience makes it essential that this potential route of spread should be closed.
