

When is **TB pre-movement testing** being extended to younger cattle?

1 March 2007

Moving cattle from a 1 or 2 yearly TB tested herd?

- If the animals are over 42 days old they will have to be pre-movement tested – unless they meet an exemption.
- Remember to give your Local Veterinary Practice plenty of notice when booking your TB tests.
- Keep your TB test chart – buyers or markets are likely to want copies.

Bringing cattle into your herd?

- Reduce the risk of introducing TB by asking for evidence of a clear TB test (within 60 days prior to movement) or proof of exemption.
- If you want to establish an Exempt Finishing Unit contact your local AHDO.

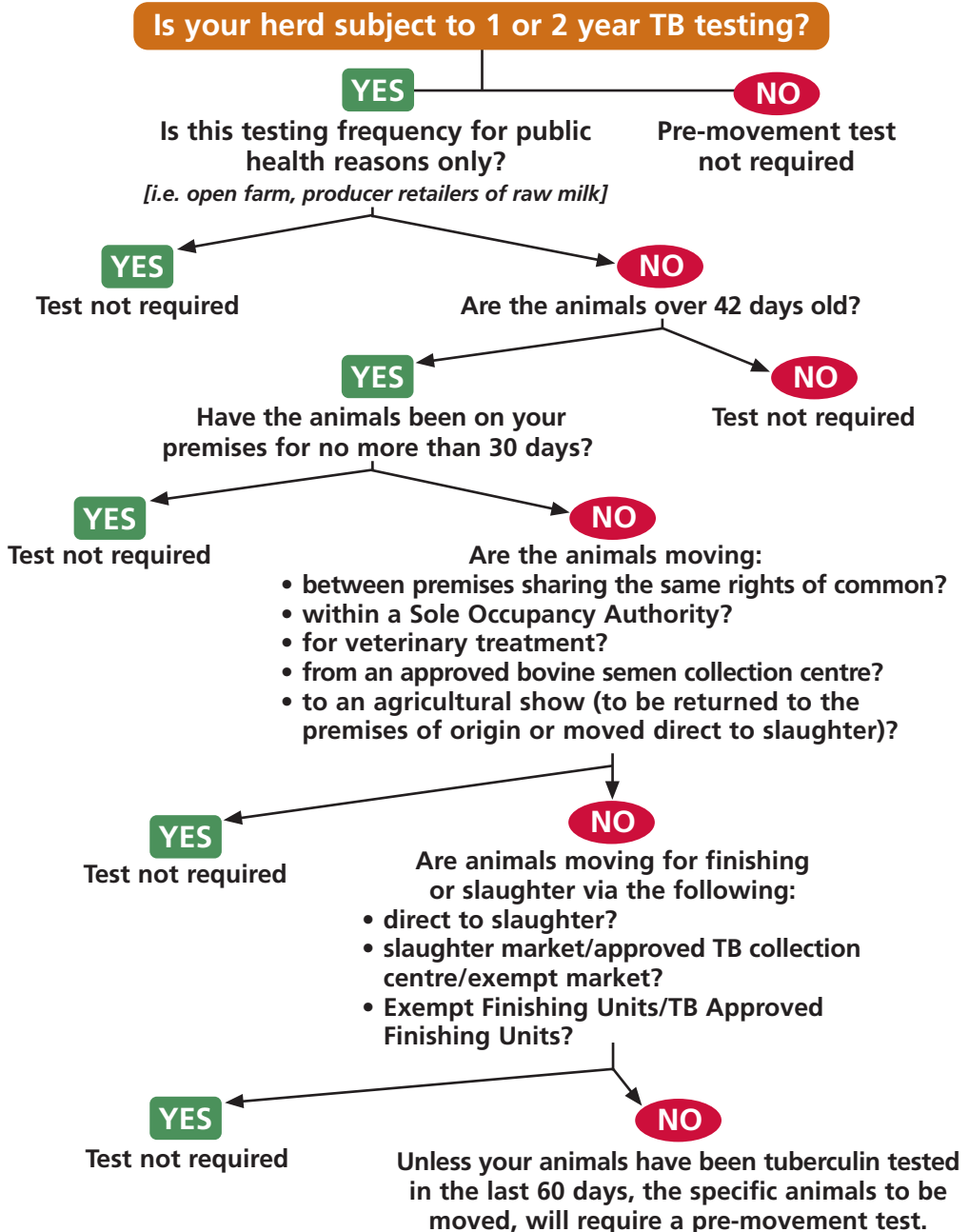
